**Paddle Lake Pleasant**

Bring your kayak or canoe on Thursday and enjoy a tour of the coves of Humbug Bay at Lake Pleasant. Be at the four-lane boat launch at the north end of Lake Pleasant Regional Park between 7:30 and 8 a.m. so your canoe or kayak can be loaded on to the flat-deck ferry for the trip to the cove. Bring a lunch. Paddle distance will be 5 to 10 miles. The ferry will leave the cove at 2 p.m. to return to the boat-launch area at 3 p.m. Registration is required, and there is a limit of 22 boats. Cost is \$5 for car entry plus \$2 for boat entry.
